- A Culture of Consultation & Participation: We will maintain a positive and inclusive safety culture. Through mechanisms such as Tool Box Talks, safety committees, and regular publications, we will ensure relevant OHS information is shared and that everyone has a voice in developing measures to improve health and safety at work.

In the event of an injury, we are committed to ensuring affected employees are returned to suitable and meaningful work at the earliest possible opportunity through equitable claims management and supportive rehabilitation practices.
